Garrison Keillor to visit Upstate

Author and humorist Garrison Keillor will bring his "Prairie



Home Companion" public radio show to the Upstate Feb. 12 for a live broadcast at Spartanburg Memorial Auditorium, officials said Monday.

set, said Elaine Freeman, executive director of the South Carolina ETV Endowment, which is helping sponsor the event.

Keillor is taking "Prairie Home Companion" on the road to eight cities for a brief tour, and wanted to make a stop in the Carolinas before an appearance in Florida, Ms. Freeman said. The 3,400-seat Spartanburg Memorial Auditorium was available for Feb. 12, she said.

Keillor appeared in the Upstate four years ago in a version of his old "American Radio Company of the Air" show at Furman's McAlister Auditorium.

"Prairie Home Companion," produced by American Public Radio in Minneapolis, airs 6-8 p.m. Saturdays on South Carolina Educational Radio.
